



How to Change a QR Code You Already Printed

1

Work out which kind of code you printed

Open your dashboard. If the code is sitting there, it is dynamic and you can edit it. If you made it on a free static generator and never signed up, it is static — the link is locked into the pattern and the only way to change it is to reprint.

2

If it is dynamic, open it and change the link

Click the code in your dashboard, type in the new link, and save. The printed code stays the same, but every scan from now on heads to the new link.

3

Check it with your own phone

Scan the printed code (or any copy of it) and make sure the new link opens. Changes happen instantly, so you can confirm in a few seconds.

4

If it is static, reprint — and go dynamic this time

Static codes cannot be edited, because the link is built right into the pattern. Reprint with the correct link, but make the new one a dynamic QR code on Easy QR so next time a change is just a quick dashboard edit.

5

Keep an eye on the corrected code

Dynamic codes record every scan, so you can confirm people are landing on the right link now — and get a feel for how much traffic that printed code is really pulling in.
