



How to Make a QR Code for a Google Doc

1

Open your Google Doc

A laptop or desktop is easiest here, because the sharing options are clearer. Click the green Share button in the top-right corner.

2

Let anyone with the link view it

In the sharing box, switch the dropdown from "Restricted" to "Anyone with the link," and set the role to Viewer so people can read it but not change it. Miss this and the code only works for people inside your organization.

3

Tap Copy link

You will end up with a link that looks like docs.google.com/document/d/.../edit.

4

Paste the link into Easy QR

Your QR code appears right away. Download it as a PNG, JPG, or SVG.

5

Scan it yourself first

Test the code with your own phone before printing a big batch. If you see a "Request access" message, the sharing setting still needs a tweak.
