



How to Make a QR Code for a Google Form

1

Open your Google Form and tap Send

In the sharing box, click the link icon tab and copy the form address. You can tick "Shorten URL" for a neater forms.gle link if you like — it behaves the same in the QR code.

2

Paste the link into Easy QR

On the home page, drop the link into the box. Your QR code preview appears straight away. Download it as a PNG, JPG, or SVG.

3

Put it where people will scan

A classroom slide, an event poster, a table tent, a receipt, a handout at the door — anywhere a phone camera can reach it.

4

Want to swap forms later? Make it editable

Reusing the same flyer or sign for different forms over time? Create an account and make a dynamic QR code instead — then you can point it at a new form whenever you want, no reprinting.
